Conduction of the event:

For Women teams: Double Round Robin

- C1: Ice Baby
C2: UTE Nők
C3: Polipok Girls

The remaining 8 teams will play their group matches in two groups. The group order is as follows:

Group A:

- A1: Legija Zagreb
A2: Rolling Stones
A3: SSC Vulptices
A4: Polipok Men

Group B:

- B1: UTE United Leads
B2: SSC Férfiak
B3: Ice Beast
B4: PTSE Titánok

Play off:

- Women: 2nd and 3rd place teams play semi-finals, followed by a final match with the 1st place team in the double round robin

- Mens: 1st-4th Page system, 5th-8th play off matches

Competitions when teams play in two groups for the play-off game(s) the choices for stone handle colour and playing first or second stone in the first end are determined as follows:

- (i) When a 1st ranked team from either group plays a team ranked #2, the team ranked #1 has the choice of stone colour and playing first or second stone in the first end. If a 1st ranked team plays the other 1st ranked team, the team with the lesser DSC has the choice of either the first or second practice or stone handle colour. The regular LSD procedures will determine which team has the choice of delivering the first or second stone in the first end.
- (ii) If a 3rd or 4th ranked team plays the other 3rd ranked team, the team with the lesser DSC has the choice of either the first or second practice or stone handle colour. The regular LSD procedures will determine which team has the choice of delivering the first or second stone in the first end

Teams will have 30-30 minutes thinking time. Wheelchair team(s) will have 38-38 minutes thinking time.

The times in the schedule are the start times of the matches. During the round robin, the warm-up will start 20 minutes before the time shown in the schedule, while in the play-offs it will start 15 minutes before the time shown in the schedule!

Communication with the coach or a substitute is allowed not only at half-time but during all breaks

It is not allowed to throw away the first stone of an end before the expiry of the time that marks the pause between ends. In the next 10 seconds the teams have time to throw the first stone of the next end, after that the judges start the team's thinking time. The same applies to the half-time break.

The referees will also make the travel time visible to the teams. Due to the accessibility of the two ends of the court, the travel time to the side closest to the coach is 20 seconds, depending on accessibility. For the opposite side of the court the travel time is 40 seconds.

Only brushes validated by the WCF may be used during the championship.
